

Summer Motorized Trail Pass Grant Program

The Summer Motorized Trail Pass Grant Program (SMTP) is a new state program that provides funding for the development, renovation, and maintenance of motorized trails on public lands in Montana (23-2-113, MCA). The SMTP is administered by Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks. The SMTP was authorized by the Montana Legislature in 2019. The program's funding comes from the sale of the Montana resident \$20 Summer OHV Trail Pass that is valid for two years.

Eligible SMTP Projects

- Signage-Trail Markers
- Trail Maintenance
- Trail Improvements
- Trail Reroutes
- Mitigation of Motorized Resource Impacts
- Brushing and Delimbing of Trails
- Noxious Weed Control on Trail Corridors
- Club Hired Trail Steward to Clear and Maintain Trails

Ineligible SMTP Projects

- Trailheads/parking areas
- Restrooms
- Motorized skill parks
- Equipment purchases
- For Profit Trails
- Private Trails
