I think the proposed rule is still confusing. It does not define what is meant "to aid in taking or locating game animals". Certainly tell your hunting buddy: "Bob there's an elk just below your position.;" is definitely aiding taking a game animal. But what if I post my location to my hunting partner on my Rhino and poll his location in a similar fashion. Is that aiding taking a game animal or is it a legitimate safety purpose. And, what is a safety purpose and what might be another legitimate purpose; just some examples might help.

I have been hunting many times and in the past would lose my partner quickly. Now with a GPS enabled Rhino, I can know where my partner is rather easily. So, is knowing where my partner might be an act of 'aiding' in the taking, or is a safety or other legitimate purpose?

I didn't compare the new rule with the past rule, but I don't recall much difference.
