Agenda Item: 2020-2021 Game Damage/Management Seasons/Wildlife Health & Special CWD hunt quotas

Action Needed: Final

Background: Game Damage/Management Season/Wildlife Health harvest quotas are adopted biennially for each region for deer, elk, and antelope, and Special CWD hunt quotas are adopted statewide for deer, elk, and moose. These quotas represent authority and limits to prescribed harvest from any future game damage hunts and/or management seasons and hunts to address wildlife health issues such as brucellosis, tuberculosis, and CWD. To clarify, these quotas represent the upper limits to potential prescribed harvest—not necessarily permit/license numbers or hunter numbers. FWP is proposing no change from the 2018-2019 quotas and no change from the December adoption addressing these quotas.

Game Damage/Management Season/Wildlife Health maximum harvest quotas for 2020 and 2021.

Special CWD Hunt maximum harvest quotas for 2020 and 2021.

Alternatives and Analysis: Proposals may be adopted as proposed, with adjustment, with additions, with deletions, or no change from 2019 (status quo). No change would challenge the supporting justifications behind proposals.

Public Involvement Process & Results: Public comment was taken from Dec. 5 to Jan. 27 and forwarded to commissioners and FWP staff for their consideration.

Proposed Motion: I move that the Fish and Wildlife Commission adopt as final the 2020 and 2021 Game Damage/ Management Season/Wildlife Health and Special CWD Hunt Quota authorizations as proposed by FWP.
