FOAM supports the recommendation of Fish, Wildlife & Parks (FWP) that they make application to the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) to temporarily change the irrigation water rights to instream flow for a period of 30-years in accordance with the Water Right Lease Agreement.

Rock Creek, a tributary to the Yellowstone River, is located about one mile downstream from Tom Miner Creek in the Paradise Valley. The creek provides habitat for resident native Yellowstone cutthroat trout and spawning habitat for trout that live in the Yellowstone River. Stoughten Creek is a major tributary of Rock Creek.
