

**FWP proposal to be amended:** Deer-Elk Regulations

**Proposed amendment:** I move the Fish and Wildlife Commission adopt the 2024 and 2025 deer hunting regulations as presented with the following amendment; eliminate the proposal to realign the hunting district boundaries between deer-elk HD 339 and 421 and retain the existing boundary as described on page 26 and 29 in the 2022–2023 Hunting District Legal Descriptions.

**Requested by FWP:** Yes

**Rationale and Background:**

This amendment removes a proposal that was developed by the department to adjust hunting district boundaries. Public comment to the proposed realignment was predominantly in opposition and there is no compelling biological reason to realign the boundary. The department would prefer to retain the existing boundary between the hunting districts rather than alter the boundaries and create possible confusion.
