The increased interest in the hunt shown by increased tag sales and hunter participation has put more pressure on the quotas. 4 of the 5 districts went over harvest this year (2024.) There were also multiple districts that went over harvest last year, with 502 being over quota by 100%. 4 of the last 5 years we have had districts go over harvest. Many of these rams were taken outside of the proposed closure time (24 hour report, 24 hour closure,) showing that multiple rams that were over quota would NOT have been harvested if this amendment had been in place. The harvest data shows this WILL have a positive impact on the populations.

With current technology (InReach etc) and increased cell coverage in these units, there is absolutely no reason a hunter cannot report harvest within 24 hours and check the quota status every day if the closure is moved to 24 hours. These sheep populations are a very limited resource with only quota of only 2 rams per unit. These 5 Unlimited units are the only over the counter sheep hunting opportunity in North America. This amendment will help protect all 5 districts populations to stay within harvest quota numbers, it is a necessity we implement this new shorter closure time frame to protect these hunts for future opportunities.
