



## **Supplemental Document 10/28/2024**

### **Clarification of Recreational Trapping and Trapping for Livestock Protection**

**Fish and Wildlife Commission Meeting – November 12, 2024**

On Friday, 10/25/2024, FWP posted proposed additional wolf and other species trapping regulations within and outside the geographic scope identified by federal court order. The proposal makes a distinction between recreational trapping for coyotes and other predatory/nongame species and trapping those species for livestock protection. This supplemental document does not change FWP's proposal but does seek to clarify how recreational and livestock protection trapping would be impacted by the proposal.

Recreational trappers pursuing coyotes and other predatory/nongame species inside the geographic scope identified by federal court order:

Free supplemental trapping permit required starting December 1.

Required adjustments to traps and snares if a grizzly bear is captured in a trap or snare.

Trappers pursuing coyotes and other predatory/nongame species for livestock protection inside the geographic scope identified by federal court order:

Free supplemental trapping permit required starting December 1.

Complete signed affidavit attesting to livestock protection trapping efforts.

Recreational trappers and trappers trapping for livestock protection outside the geographic scope identified by federal court order: No change from 2023 regulations.
