Draft Environmental Assessment for Interim Translocation of Bison Addendum—September 20, 2011

This addendum to the "Draft Environmental Assessment for Interim Translocation of Bison" lists a range of costs and materials that could be used for proposed infrastructure improvements.

The interim locations include the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation near Malta and the Fort Peck Indian Reservation near Wolf Point. Wildlife management areas assessed are the 5,800-acre Marias River WMA near Shelby and the 28,000-acre Spotted Dog WMA near Avon.

This addendum also emphasizes that if there is a finding during the public comment period that leads to the elimination of one of the sites, then the total acres assessed, and the total number of bison that could be placed on any of the remaining locations, could also be adjusted.

FWP has extended the comment period to 5 p.m. Oct. 19.
