Apprentice Hunter Certification Form

A person 10 years of age or older may be certified to receive an apprentice hunting license and may hunt in Montana, without hunter education, when accompanied by a mentor. Apprentice hunters may obtain the Apprentice Hunter Certification for **no more than 2 license years** (certification must be done each year) before they must complete a hunter safety and education course.

The apprentice must pay a \$5 fee online or in person to an FWP office in order to be certified as an Apprentice Hunter. The Apprentice must also purchase a Conservation License along with any appropriate Montana hunting license(s) for the species being hunted.

***Montana resident:** must present a valid Montana Drivers License or ID Card at the time of license purchase; if apprentice is under 18 years of age, a valid parent's or legal guardian's Drivers License or ID Card must be presented at the time of license purchase as proof of residency.
